BOARD BRIEFS

NEIGHBORHOOD PROBLEM SOLVING

Over the years, our Property Committee has been the primary group which has been responsible for dealing with the various problems which develop within a community. Several years ago, once Myrtle Trace was completely built, the Property Committee established Phase Representatives and publicized the names of the committee members with their specific responsibilities. These assignments always appear on the back page of our community phone directory. Problems should always be reported to the specific responsible committee member rather than to the Committee Chairman. This will almost always result in a quicker resolution. Your cooperation will be appreciated.

E-MAIL PROBLEMS

Many of us who are using the Horry Telephone Cooperative internet service are still having difficulty with the delivery of some e-mail messages both incoming and outgoing. If your e-mail address ends with "@sccoast.net", you are served by HTC. To determine if you have a problem, send an e-mail message to a friend or neighbor who has the same address ending. Then, ask them to send a message back to you. If both messages are received, you don't have a transmission problem. If they don't receive your message, they have a problem. If you don't receive their message, you have a problem. In either case, one of you should call HTC. In the meantime, you should be able to access the missing e-mail by getting on the Internet and going to "htcnetracer.net". Once there, click on Web Mail. It will ask you for your username and password. It will then display your In Box with all of your mail for the past 30 days. You can also view the spam which has been blocked and you will be able to recover the messages which should not be spam. For assistance from HTC, call 369-8617 during normal business hours or 369-8745 during off hours.

MYRTLE TRACE HOA DUES

As part of our regular communications, the following information is furnished to residents to assist them when making their MTHOA dues payment. The drop-off location for dues is the first slot on your left as you approach the front door to the Clubhouse. If you mail your payment, the address is MTHOA, 101 Myrtle Trace Drive, Conway, SC 29526. Please make your check out to the MTHOA or Myrtle Trace HOA as you prefer. Residents who wish to have automatic payment services should contact their bank to make the necessary arrangements. Payments may be made monthly, quarterly, semi-annually or annually as desired.

The MTHOA mailbox located at 101 Myrtle Trace Drive is for US Postal Service delivery only. Please do not put your payment in this USPS mailbox.

The HOA dues are currently \$60.00 per month and are due on the first of each month and a grace period through the end of the month is provided prior to the assessment of a service charge. If you need more information about your account, please contact Karen Bevan at 234-2315.

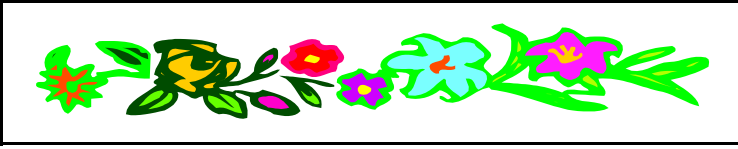

GARDEN CLUB

The Garden Club will kick off the fall season with a meeting at the Clubhouse on Thursday, September 2nd at 2 pm and all Tracers are invited to attend. As one may expect, the two month layoff from meetings (because of excessive heat & humidity) also means that there will be a crying need for cleanup projects as well as getting ready for the fall plantings and fall fertilization of certain plants. We shall need all of the help we can get so please consider giving our "regulars" a helping hand.

Several calls have been received recently concerning a problem with Crape Myrtles in Myrtle Trace (and other local areas). When these plants were checked, it was determined that the problem was that of damage being caused by an outbreak of aphids. These are tiny insects with piercing, sucking mouthparts and they often undergo a tremendous population explosion during warm, humid weather. In addition to the physical damage to the leaves, their excretia (which has a high sugar content) serves as a food source for a fungus which causes a problem known as Sooty Mold. The fungus is **not** a parasite, but it can quickly form a black layer over the entire surface of leaves which is very unsightly. This layer can effectively stop the process of photosynthesis which is vital to the health of the affected plant. Controlling the aphids will also reduce the damage caused by the fungus. The use of NEEM (a natural plant derivative) or SEVIN (when used as per label instructions) are very effective in the control of aphids.
